



Holy Trinity Continuity of Learning Plan

Holy Trinity will provide instruction through an asynchronous remote learning environment using the following instructional tools:

1. Instructional Learning Packets
 - a. Learning packets are provided for students on a weekly basis.
 - b. Parents are asked to pick up a packet each week and return the packet from the previous week.
2. Google Classroom
 - a. Additional materials may be posted on google classroom depending on the grade level of the student.
3. Video Conferencing (Zoom/Google Meet)
 - a. Video conferencing will be used to supplement instructional activities included in learning packets.
 - b. Video conferencing will be used to provide social interaction among students.
 - c. Teachers will utilize video conferencing to provide opportunities for students to ask question on learning packets.
 - d. Teachers will use and record video conferencing in providing new instruction.

Grading

1. Grades for the 4th quarter of the 2019-2020 school year will be based upon completion of assigned activity as well as growth and understanding.
2. Students are expected to complete assigned learning activities and return them when picking up new packets.
3. Teachers will provide feedback to parents/students on completed work.



Cedar Catholic Continuity of Learning Plan

Cedar Catholic will provide instruction through an asynchronous remote learning environment using the following instructional tools:

1. Google Classroom
 - a. Weekly learning plans are posted in Google Classroom for each course.
 - b. Teachers post videos, learning activities, and other course-related information on Google Classroom.
2. Instructional Learning Packets
 - a. Some courses may utilize paper-based learning packets if digital resources are not available or not applicable for learning activity.
3. Video Conferencing (Zoom/Google Meet)
 - a. Video conferencing will be used to supplement assigned learning activities.
 - b. Video conferencing will be used to provide opportunities for students to ask question related learning activities and assignments.
 - c. Teachers will utilize and record video conferencing sessions to provide new instruction.
 - d. Teachers will utilize Google Meet/Zoom to provide one-on-one and small group instruction and reinforcement.

Grading

1. Grades for the 4th quarter of the 2019-2020 school year will be based upon completion of assigned activities as well as growth and understanding on the content.
2. Students are expected to complete all assigned learning activities which will be used to calculate the students' 4th quarter and semester grades.
