

SHAMROCK INVITATIONAL VOLLEYBALL TOURNAMENT

Saturday, September 5, 2020

- 1. The tournament will be held at Scotus Central Catholic, 1554 18th Avenue. Games will be played in Memorial Hall and the Activity Center. Enter on the north side of the building.
- 2. Session I 9:00 am/10:00 am Session II 12:00/1:00 pm Session III 2:30 pm/3:30 pm
- 3. Officials: J. Steiner and K. Koehlmoos and their partners
 - Session I Activity Center Steiner Memorial Hall – Koehlmoos
 - Session II Activity Center Koehlmoos Memorial Hall – Steiner
 - Session III Activity Center Steiner Memorial Hall – Koehlmoos
- 4. Power points and common regular season opponents were considered in first round pairings.
- Players, coaches and support personnel arriving with the team will be admitted free of charge. Each team will receive 36 tickets in the mail. These tickets allow spectators to purchase admittance at the gate for \$6.00.
- 6. Top team in bracket (home team) is responsible for official book. Bottom team in bracket is responsible for libero tracker. There is no entry fee, but we ask that each school supply an adult line judge for each of their three matches. Line judges need to report 20 minutes before match starts. If these workers do not arrive with the team, they will need a ticket to purchase admittance at the gate for \$6.00.
- 7. Trophies will be presented to the top three teams, plus the consolation champion.
- 8. Admission: \$6.00 (only with tickets sent to schools/no other spectators will be admitted.)
- 9. Schools may videotape or film any match they are playing, but these may not be used until after the completion of the match. Schools may not video or film a match if they are not involved in the match.
- 10. Radio broadcasts are permitted at no charge.

- 11. No cheerleaders will be admitted.
- 12. Please email rosters and names of line judges to: <u>ahash@scotuscc.org</u> by **Monday, August 31.**
- 13. Each team will be assigned a classroom for the day. Outside food must remain in the team room. The cafeteria will not be open for team camps. We ask that you please clean up your room before you leave for the day.
- 14. There will be no hospitality room. The teachers' lounge will be reserved for officials and media. Concession stand will be available with limited offerings.

15. We encourage masks when your team is in the gym, hallways and restrooms. Masks are encouraged for spectators.

16. Bus Driver Instructions: Please inform your driver to drop off athletes at the doors on the north side of Scotus. Buses may be parked on the west side of 19th Avenue. We have a parking lot directly north of school but getting buses in and out of the lot is not easy.

Scotus Central Catholic High School COVID-19 Guidelines

All procedures have been developed using current directive health measures (DHM) and NSAA mandates and guidelines.

Game Protocol

- Teams will not switch benches. Home team will occupy the east bench in Dowd Center and south bench in Memorial Hall.
- Scotus will provide warmup balls in both gyms. The balls will be sanitized between matches.
- Water fountains will not be available. Water bottle fillers will be available. Teams should fill their own water bottles with the bottle fillers on the fountains.
- There will be no pre-game or post-game handshake.
- Children should be seated with their parents.
- Fans and students should not go onto the court at the conclusion of the game.
- Fans and students are encouraged to leave the facility at the conclusion of the game.
- Restrooms will be available south of the concession stand.

Masks and Face Coverings

- Fans are encouraged to wear masks/coverings.
- Scotus players will wear masks/coverings when not competing.
- Scotus coaches will wear masks/coverings when they cannot socially distance.
- Game officials will not be required to wear masks/coverings.
- Concession workers will wear masks/coverings and gloves.
