Current Level: Yellow

Capacity: Our main gym capacity is 899. With current recommendations of 50% from the DHM, our full capacity will be 450. If we reach capacity, we will deny fans. Our activity center gym capacity is 267. With current recommendations of 50% from the DHM, our full capacity will be 134. Once full capacity is reached, we will deny fans.
